## REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Rimfire Pacific Mining Limited (ASX: **RIM**) (the **Company**) requests an immediate suspension of the Company's ordinary shares (RIM) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) be granted in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.

The voluntary suspension is requested pending an announcement by the Company to the market regarding an update in relation to receipt of funds from Golden Plains Resources Pty Ltd in relation to the Fifield Project Earn-in ("**stated purpose**") as referred to in the Company's letter dated 26 July 2022.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

1. The voluntary suspension is necessary to assist the Company in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make an announcement to the market in relation to the stated purpose.
2. The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of commencement of normal trading on Thursday, 4 August 2022, or when the announcement regarding the stated purpose is released to the market.
3. The Company expects to make the announcement to the market before the commencement of normal trading on Thursday, 4 August 2022.
4. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
