Rimfire Pacific Mining has reported the third-best drill result from its Sorpresa project in New South Wales.

The hole returned 9m at 18.15 grams per tonne gold and 100gpt silver from 18m.

West African Resources has released further high-grade results from its Tanlouka project in Burkina Faso.

Diamond drilling at M1 hit 14m at 4.5gpt gold, including 3m at 16.2gpt gold. The hole extended mineralisation down-dip and is likely to add to project resources.

Drilling at **Terrain Minerals'** Monet prospect, part of the Rembrandt project in Western Australia, has returned multiple high-grade results.

The best results from aircore drilling included 1m at 17.9gpt gold from 26m; 1m at 80.4gpt gold from 43m; 1m at 18.85gpt gold from 11m; 1m at 20gpt gold from 16m; and 1m at 10.3gpt gold from 28m.

Mineralisation remains open at depth.

Finally, **Axiom Mining** has released more results from resource definition drilling at its Isabel nickel project in the Solomon Islands.

New results included 13.6m at 1.62% nickel from surface, including 9m at 1.93% nickel; 11m at 1.92% nickel from surface, including 8m at 2.22% nickel; and 15m at 1.55% nickel from 1m, including 10m at 1.84% nickel.
